JUNIOR ENGLISH PROGRAMMES

From July 2012 Rosemont School operating from its new location and state-of-the art facilities will offer a suite of new programmes, including short-term customised programmes in English Language and a wide range of cultural and sporting activities.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE

English language programmes will be designed to meet the needs of the individual group and can range from 15 to 20 hours per week. The minimum entry requirement for a Junior Programme is beginners' level. Customised programmes will be designed to accommodate different English language levels provided that a threshold number of students is reached. Students will be tested on arrival to determine the level that best corresponds to their needs.

English tuition will cover all four essential skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking with an emphasis on maximising the opportunities afforded by living in an English-speaking environment. A typical programme offers 15 to 20 tuition periods per week depending on the request of the group.

AGE AND DURATION

Groups aged 10-18 may apply. Junior programmes can last from two to ten weeks. The minimum duration is ten days.

ACCOMMODATION

Host family accommodation is available for all students. Students are hosted with families whose daughters are attending Rosemont, or who are linked to the school. Families are carefully chosen to provide a home-to-home experience. Host family accommodation includes breakfast and evening meal and a packed lunch.

Students should be conscious of the fact that they are going to live in a country with a different culture to what they are used to. They will have to adapt their behaviour and habits to that culture. Specifically as regards living in a family and attending school they will have to follow established codes of conduct.

ACTIVITIES AND OUTINGS

Sample activities include pitch and putt, tennis, basketball, hockey, cinema, Irish dancing and music as well as cultural visits to the many sites Dublin has to offer. Full day excursions range from trips to Galway, Kilkenny, Belfast or Glendalough to specialised visits such as the Causey Farm Experience or the many chocolate factories Dublin is home to!

- Use of textbooks and teaching materials
- Diploma on completion of course
- Transport to school Monday to Friday
- Transport from the airport on arrival and departure

- Registration and administration fees
