Fees Information

School Fees 2016/2017

Fees €4,800

Fees for second sister in the school €4,320

Fees for third sister in the school €2,880 (40% reduction)

Fees for fourth sister in the school €1,920 (60% reduction)

(The reduction applies when children are concurrently enrolled in the school)

Rosemont School Fee Information for Parents

Invoices for school fees are sent out in July for the following academic year. An administration charge of €100 is also included in the Invoice

Parents are given a number of options for payment:

- Payment in full on or before 1st September (1)
- Twice Yearly: August 15th and January 15th
- Payment in 10th equal monthly instalments of €490 commencing July 31st

(1) A €100 reduction applies for fees paid in full prior to 1st September

Parents must notify the school of their intended method of payment before the start of the school year.

Payment is accepted by cheque, bank transfer, standing order, direct debit or through "Easy Payments" on www.rosemont.ie

Payment Policy

- No reduction can be made for temporary absence.
- A term's notice in writing is required before a student leaves the school; otherwise liability for fees is incurred.
- All outstanding balances must be cleared before 31st May of the current academic year.

Should any sums owing by parents remain unpaid for more than one month after the date they become due for payment, contact will be made with parents. The School reserves the right to withhold school reports and participation from certain school trips and events until the payment situation is regularised.

In the event of non-payment of school fees by 31st May of the current academic year, the school reserves the right to remove the student from the School roll for the following academic year.

The Student Bursary Programme

A limited bursary scheme exists, to help parents in situations of financial difficulty. It is administered by the Board of Trustees. Application for bursary assistance, which is means-tested, should be made through the Administration Office. The Student Bursary Programme Policy and Application form is available on the school website.

The Academic Scholarship Award

The Board of Management offer two academic scholarships yearly for girls entering first year. These are full scholarships covering tuition fees for a period of up to six years. The Academic Scholarship Award information is available on the school website.
