School uniform

- Rosemont tartan kilt *; length below the knee
- Rosemont navy jumper with school crest *
- 5 White blouses, with collar and reveres. Blouses should always be tucked in. A plain white collarless t-shirt may be worn under blouses if required.
- Navy knee-high socks or tights

Plain, flat black shoes. No high heels, platforms, sling-backs, boots, trainers or sporting shoes may be worn with uniform. No trims or embellishments in any other colour.

'Penny Loafers' as stocked in O'Farrell's Shops are suitable for school shoes.

Plain navy coat (for outdoor wear only). School jackets must be plain navy, with no metallic or fur trims or other decorations, no other colour, and no emblems of sports clubs or of any other establishment (including other schools or companies). The uniform shop in Stillorgan Shopping Centre provides a suitable coat. Only navy scarves may be worn.

Smock, overall, or 'Grandfather shirt' for Art class to cover uniform completely (design and colour of your own choice).

2 white coats – one for Lab work and one for Home Economics.

PE

- Rosemont navy tracksuit bottoms * (new version available August 2018)
- Rosemont sports top*
- Rosemont Hoodie* (may *only* be worn for PE)

Optional PE gear, depending on sports played:

- Rosemont Skort for hockey &/or netball *
- Rosemont PE shorts * (new version available August 2018)
- Rosemont basketball shorts * (new version available August 2018)
- Red hockey socks *
- Hockey stick & shin pads
- Gum shield essential for hockey matches and training
- Plain white polo shirt for team training

Only Rosemont PE uniform may be worn during school sports activities.

Sports shoes must be worn for PE; casual footwear is inadequate for sports safety.

Standard of uniform:

- All items are to be in a good state of repair; otherwise they must be replaced.
- No stains are acceptable on any item of uniform. All items must be cleaned, or if the stain cannot be removed, the item must be replaced.
- Shoes must be plain black, and flat. Shoes must be in good condition, scuff-free. Shoes which are broken must be replaced for safety reasons.
