Homework Guidelines

1st Year (1.5 hours per night weekdays)

Irish:

Written, Learning, Aural

12-15 minutes per night, comprised of learning and written work and occasionally aural work

English:

1st year: 10-15 minutes per night. Learning or reading or written work. 20-30 minutes at the weekend. 1 hour reading time for their novel each week.

Maths:

15 to 20 minutes daily, completing exercise questions

History:

10-15 minutes per night. Learning and/or written work. 20-30 minutes at the weekend. 1 project per term.

Geography:

3 homework sessions per week. 15 minutes each – written exercise & learning work. 1 project per term.

Art:

once a week (15 – 30 minutes)

Homework includes observational drawing; visual research & support studies relating to class work & is to be completed in the sketchbook or scrapbook.

R.E.:

10 min assignment 2 evenings per week.

Home Economics:

1 double class + 1 single class

double: prep during the week before for practical class 10-15 mins

evening of double class (a) evaluation sheet OR (b) finish set work (10 mins)

single: 20 mins – learning and/or written

weekend: encourage students to apply skills learned in class as home. E.g.: home baking.

Homework Guidelines

Science:

20 minutes (4 sessions per wk)

To consist of – 5min review of class work; 5min learning/oral work; 10 min written exercise. At least one of these sessions to be dedicated to relevant revision topic (as per year plan)

Spanish:

15 minutes per session. 10 written and 5 mins learning work.

French:

15 mins: 10 minutes per session written and 5 learning

CSPE:

15 minutes once per week. Learning, written or research work. Best done on the same evening as had class. 1 project per term.

SPHE

10 minutes once per week. Learning, written or research work. Best done on the same evening as had class.

Music:

1 written exercise – 15 mins. After Christmas 15 mins practise of instrument (recorder). One project per term.
